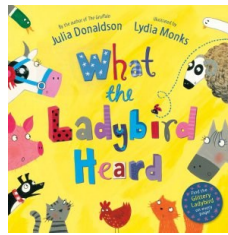




Please keep reading with your child every day. This is having a great impact on their reading levels.

In science we will be planting seeds and looking after them. We will observe the seeds and learn about what they need to grow and stay healthy.

In geography we will be learning about the 4 seasons and how they are different. We will also be sorting the months of the year into the seasons.

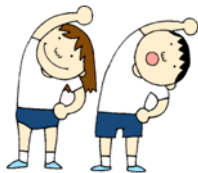
In art we will be drawing and labelling the parts of the plant, creating collages and painting trees in the different seasons.
