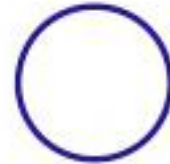
Before your child can learn to write, he or she needs to be able to draw these shapes



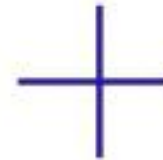

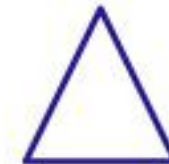
