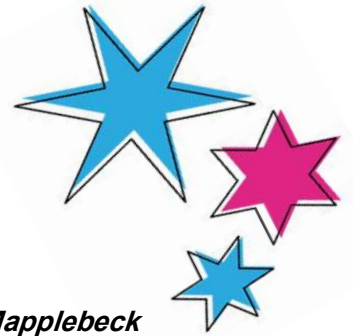

Animals through Music

Listen and Respond	<p>Listen to Camille Saint-Sains Carnival of the Animals. Pick out different animals by using the markers in the video and pictures of the animals on the screen.</p> <p>I will do this in my video tutorial, but you may want to explore further.</p>
Join in and create	<p>Create your own sounds like Saint-Seans for animals.</p> <p>Use the worksheet to help choose an animal, describe the animal, choose if the music should be loud or soft, fast or slow, smooth or short choppy sounds.</p> <p>You could record your sounds on a device. If you make up several, you could play them to an audience.</p> <p>You can create your own instruments from around the house, using pots, pans, wooden spoons etc.</p> <p>Act out the animals to their pieces of music.</p>
More ideas in the theme	<p>Make a Carnival of the Animals poster.</p> <p>Create a dance routine to The Swan music.</p> <p>Draw or paint your favourite animal from The Carnival of the Animals.</p> <p>Act out the animals to their pieces of music.</p>
Adaptations for EYFS	<p>Listen to small sound bites of the Carnival of the Animals.</p> <p>Clap the names of the animals. Kangaroo, Lion, Elephant, Swan etc Try to act out how the animals would move along to the music.</p>
