### Superhero Maths

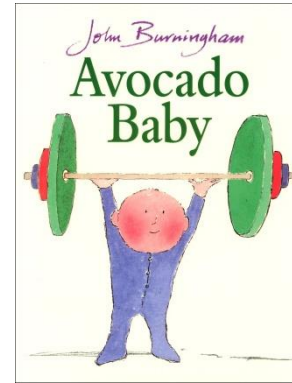
Please remember to continue practising your superhero maths at home for our superhero maths activity on a Monday. The superhero maths facts can be found on the school website in the year 1 page.
