**Remember to put names on all belongings including jumpers/cardigans and clothing such as hoodies worn for P.E.**

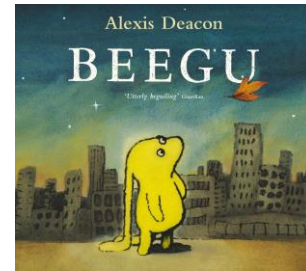
**Humanities Day**

**Topics**

This half term the book we are learning is called Beegu. We are going to be learning the story, innovating it and moving on to developing our knowledge of writing a report text all about space.
