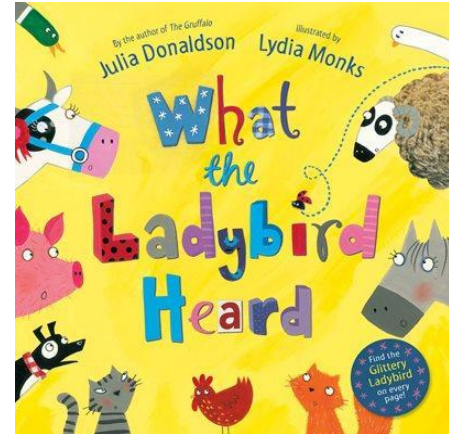
### Reading Folders
