 hear about what your children will be doing in school.

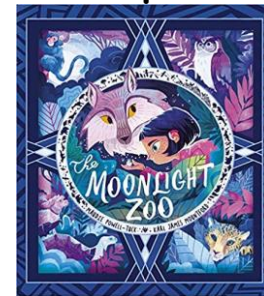
Helping Hands Meeting
