

PE AND SPORT FUNDING 2024-2025

Grindon Infant School Allocation of Funds

For the year 2024-2025 we have been allocated **£16960** for the development of PE and sport to promote fitness, healthy living and wellbeing. We offer PE sessions within school to all year groups including Nursery. In previous years, this funding has generally been used to provide sports clubs on afternoons at 3:20-4:15pm, including football, swimming and dance and for additional Coaches to come in to school in order that the children have the opportunity to try physical activities that they may not previously have had the chance to do so. This has included yoga, karate and skate and scooter sessions. In 2024-2025, we are aiming to further develop our P.E provision to promote physical fitness and health for all children with the focus on playtimes and lunchtimes. The table below sets out what we aim to provide at Grindon Infant School through the Sports funding that we will receive this year.
